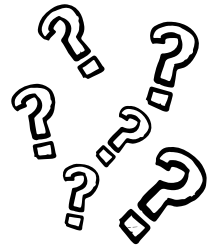


Who was Christopher Columbus?

The Voyage (1492)

- Columbus reached islands in the Caribbean.
- He thought he had reached Asia, but it was a “New World.”

- He showed courage, faith, and determination to sail into the unknown.
